False Bay 'Slow' Chenin Blanc Stellenbosch, South Africa	£6.50 - £8.50 - £17.00 - £25

Crafted the wild way - old vine fruit, fermented with wild yeast found naturally on the grapes...not in a packet. This magical transformation takes at least six months.

Old Vine Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie Loire Valley, France	£9.00 - £10.00 - £19 - £29
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Les Grande Presbytères is based in St Fiacre, southeast of Nantes and was established by Nelly Marzelleau's grandfather in the 1950s. St Fiacre is considered one of the best sites for Muscadet due to its soil composition. Wines are made from vines close to 50 years in age - a rarity in the area as most are dug up after 40 years.

The Whale Watcher Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand	£9.00 - £10.00 - £19 - £29
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Judiciously sourced from 3 vineyard sites between the Waihopai, Wairau and Awatere Valleys.

l'Ormarine 'Duc de Morny' Picpoul de Pinet Languedoc, France	£30
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Cave de l'Ormarine is an award-winning co-operative which produces wines from the tiny Pinet de Picpoul appellation in the Hérault. The Ormarine cellar was established in 1922 when winegrowers from Pinet joined forces and formed a winegrowers' association.

Marchesi di Grèsy Sauvignon Blanc Langhe, Italy	£37
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A fine and rare Sauvignon Blanc from the Barbaresco zone - with great depth and purity. Marchesi di Grèsy has long been recognised as one of Piemonte's top producers. Exclusively owned by the di Grèsy family since 1797. It is here that grapes from each of the estates are taken to be vinified. Alberto di Grèsy owns and manages the estate. His philosophy is simple but effective; to produce wines using the best available technology that respect tradition and promote the character and personality of the terrain and grape variety.

## ROSÉ

Dom. de la Vieille Tour Provence Rosé Cotes de Provence, France	£9.00 - £10.00 - £19 - £29
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A stunning 22 hectare Côtes de Provence estate situated between Pierrefeu and Cuers. The Domaine's vineyards benefit from lying in a slight geographical depression which has a particular micro climate, encouraging long and even ripening of the grapes. Grapes for the rosé, Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault, are cultivated on sandstone clay soils and harvested by hand, before being transported to a very modern, gravity-fed winery.

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95% Chardonnay - 5% Pinot Noir  
Established in 1991 by the Gatti family, ran by both parents & children, which has now become one of the finest Franciacorta wineries, using the same production methods as Champagne makers.

## RED

Pasquiers Grenache Noir Pays d'Oc, France	£5.50 - £7.00 - £13.50 - £20

False Bay 'Bush Vine' Pinotage Stellenbosch, South Africa	£6.50 - £8.50 - £17.00 - £25
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Bush Vine Pinotage is not from irrigated, over-cropped vines shackled to wires in horrifically hot and stressed out vineyards. The wine is from coastal, dry-farmed bush vines which have had time to adapt and find their happy place.

Il Cascinone 'Crocera' Barbera d'Asti Piemonte, Italy	£9.00 - £10.00 - £19 - £29
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From the Single vineyard 'Crocera' on the estate of Il Cascinone in the Monferrato hills of Piemonte. Barbera is the most important grape in the region, producing distinctive wines. The wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barriques, of which 10-15% is new oak.

Le Fou Pinot Noir Languedoc, France	£7.50 - £9.50 - £18 - £28
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An unique take on Pinot Noir from two growers' plantings in the sun drenched vineyards of the Southern Languedoc. 'Le Fou' translates as 'The Madman', as it has long been thought only a madman would try to produce the perfect Pinot Noir in southern France.

'Les Coteaux' Cotes du Rhone Villages Southern Rhone, France	£30
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Exceptional Grenache and Syrah from the best Côtes du Rhône Villages, which is then enriched with classified wine from Séguret, Sablet and the cru of Cairanne.

I Muri Primitivo Puglia, Italy	£28
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Filippo, a native of Piemonte, has been working in Puglia for almost two decades and has always been allured by the rich, ripe flavours of Primitivo, and has the potential to capture these flavours with minimal use of technology and a lot of know-how.

Organic Bodegas Artesa Rioja Rioja, Spain	£30
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In order to ensure its organic status, the only barrels that can be used to mature this wine are either those that have previously held other organic wines, or completely new barrels. Artesa Organic is therefore matured in a high proportion of new barrels each vintage.

Nieto Senetiner Malbec Mendoza, Argentina	£32
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Nieto Senetiner has grown to become one of the leading stars of Mendoza. Winemaker, Santiago Mayorga, has taken the wines to another level and was named 'Young Winemaker of the year 2017' by Tim Atkin.

Marchesi di Grèsy Monferrato Rosso (100% Merlot) Barbaresco, Italy	£35
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Produced from their Monte Colombo vineyard in the Monferrato hills - combines rich vibrant fruit with elegance and great complexity. 12 months in used French barriques followed by 24 months in Slavonian oak casks.

Merum Priorati Ardiles Priorat Catalunya, Spain	£40
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One of the most important wine estates in Priorat, founded by two Catalan families. One of the wildest, most rugged terrains, where few vines thrive and those that do produce less than 250g - 1 kg of grapes per vine. Vineyards here are not measured in hectares, but by numbers of vines planted, due to extreme terracing and contours of the land.
